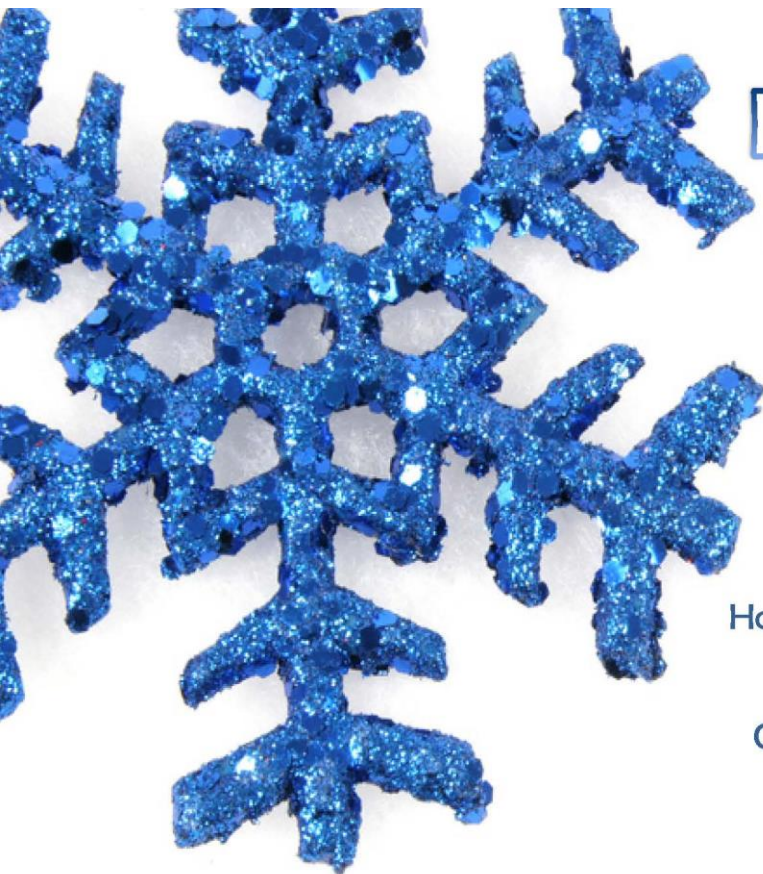

184 IW Holiday Card Competition, hosted by 184 FSS

This contest is an incentive for units to help enhance the appearance of Jayhawk Drive, show their holiday spirit during the upcoming season and provide a creative outlet for the many talented folks in our Wing.

The life-size holiday cards may be designed and submitted by flights, squadrons or groups/professional organizations (one entry per organization).

Organizations can sign up with Services at 759-7350/7351/7353 NLT COB Wednesday, 23 November. A POC is required for each organization. The POC will be assigned a location to place their card by Tuesday, 29 November.

Cards may be placed any time after 1200 hours Wednesday, 30 November and no later than 0900 hours Saturday, 3 December.

Judging will take place Saturday, 3 December at 1400 and the winners will be announced on Sunday, 6 December.

Cards will be judged on theme, originality and organization representation

The following guidelines must be followed or the organization will be disqualified

- Cards must be made of plywood. Actual card size can be no smaller than 4 ft. x 8 ft.
- Cards must fit into a 10-foot wide area and be securely anchored
- Any art form or combination may be used (paint, colored materials, 3D, etc.); however, paint and decorations should be waterproof and weather resistant
- Display must be capable of withstanding potential windy Kansas weather
- Mounted items must be securely attached
- Display must be self-supporting, nothing is to be staked or driven into the ground
- Electrical outlets will not be provided; battery operated displays are permitted
- Cards must be in good taste and contain no offensive language
- Backside of card will list organization, point of contact and phone number

Each organization is responsible for set-up, maintenance and tear-down of their card. If a card is damaged by weather, organizations have 24 hours to repair, replace or remove the card.

Cards must be removed by 4 January 2017. Any cards not removed will be destroyed.
